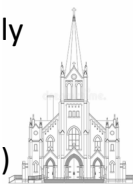

Please remember to put your name in your hand missals, prayer books, etc, in case you happen to leave them behind after Holy Mass.

Reminder - Private Revelations

It is the universal policy of all FSSP apostolates that the faithful are forbidden from promoting, in any way, condemned or unapproved private revelations. There are too many to list, but some common examples are: "Maria Divine Mercy", Medjugorje, The Divine Will, Mystical Rose and Garabandal.

It is also necessary to obtain permission before distributing any printed materials, and all prayer leaflets are required by Canon Law to have ecclesiastical permission for printing and distribution. Please notify Fr Sypher should this directive be disregarded.

If you are invited to a prayer group, it would be good to assure yourself that it is not motivated or inspired by unapproved or condemned private revelations. It is also imprudent & highly inadvisable to give any credence to a self-proclaimed seer/prophet/prophetess.

Lenten Penance

The Code of Canon Law states that all days in Lent are days of penance, apart from Sundays and First Class feast days. As a minimum, the penance can be fulfilled in many different ways such as abstaining from meat, fasting, praying 5 decades of the Rosary, going to Mass or doing the Stations of the Cross.

In Australia, Catholics 14y.o. and over are obliged to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Adults under the age of 59 are also required to fast on those two days. The obligation to fast does not apply to those doing heavy manual labour, breastfeeding/expectant mothers or those with medical conditions that necessitate a particular meal regime, etc.
